Keep in mind that everything you write here could be used in telling your Love Story, so don't write anything that you wouldn't want every guest at your wedding to know. The most important information is the information about your first date, the first time you met and the proposal. These are the basis for your relationship as well as the Love Story. Please make sure we have everything in this checklist **no later than six weeks** before your wedding date to ensure a quality product.
